

Rosmarinus officinalis 'Foxtail'

This aromatic evergreen perennial has semi prostrate growth habit, small, blue flowers and dense, nicely arranged, green foliage. It grows up to 100cm (40") high and spreads to 100cm (40") wide. The plant is native to Europe and North Africa.
